

Signs you might be bleeding internally

You might feel...



A bubbling or tingling feeling near a joint



A warm feeling in the joint or skin around it



An aura, an unusual sensation



A tight feeling in your joints



Stiff joints that are difficult to move

You might see...



Many large or deep **bruises**



Swelling around a joint or in a muscle area



Blood in **urine** or **bowel movements**



Bleeding for a long time when you get hurt, have a cut, have surgery or a tooth pulled, or even get a shot (injection)



Nosebleeds for no obvious reason



A **baby** acting **irritable** or fussy, seemingly for no reason
